

From the museum, it's a short hop to a local restaurant to satisfy your appetite at lunch, choosing from a variety of meat dishes or a tasty vegetarian plate from a set menu.

Table Mountain Aerial Cableway and Nature Walk*

Enjoy an exciting ride on the Table Mountain Aerial Cableway to the summit of Table Mountain. Then, take a privately guided nature walk along a series of paved paths through the fynbos—one of the world's most diverse floral kingdoms—and see spectacular views from your towering perch!

City Walking Tour and Shopping at Greenmarket Square

After lunch, stroll through the city's historic center and visit landmarks including Company's Garden Park, the Houses of Parliament, St. George's Cathedral and Greenmarket Square—where there are dozens of stalls featuring crafts and handmade goods from across the African continent! Lunch With a View


Savor fresh seafood and other options from a set menu at a restaurant featuring a spectacular seaside view.

Board a ferry for a ride across the Knysna Lagoon to the spectacular Featherbed Nature Reserve with its 2 sandstone cliffs—the Knysa Heads—standing like sentries on either side. Marvel at the scenery as you travel to the clifftop in a cart pulled by a 4-wheel drive Unimog—a bumpy, off-road vehicle commonly used in challenging terrains. The panoramic views from the cliffs will take your breath away! Then walk down trails through the lush reserve until you arrive at the restaurant for lunch.

Lunch at Featherbed Nature Reserve

Indulge in a buffet lunch of delicious South African dishes under the generous shade of the milkwood trees.

Dinner at Knysna Elephant Park

Visit Knysna Elephant Park, the first elephant orphanage in South Africa, and enjoy the rare opportunity oget close to these gentle giants. Afterwards, savor a delicious dinner at the park restaurant.

Time to depart the seaside beauty of Knysna for safari country, flying from George to Johannesburg to Hoedspruit. Then, ride a 4x4 safari vehicle to the Kapama River Lodge near Kruger National Park.

Arrive at Kapama River Lodge

Take a brief tour of the game reserve as your Adventure Guides check you in to this luxurious lodge, your home for the next 3 nights. A light buffet lunch is available in the Siyatla Lounge, where massive leadwood tree trunks and an open-beamed thatched roof complete the warm African interior.

Evening Game Drive*

Set off in a safari vehicle over natural terrain with a ranger and tracker for an exclusive bush safari in Big Five" country—home to lion, leopard, elephant, rhino and buffalo. Refreshments are served at sunset so you can watch the transition from day to night. The tracker will scan the horizon with a spotlight for the luminous glint of nocturnal eyes!



To assure a comfortable connection in Johannesburg, your evening flight should not be scheduled any time prior to 6:00 PM. Saysala kahle to south Africa—until you return again!



South African Safari Trip Tips

PREPARING FOR YOUR ADVENTURE

Required Travel Documentation

If you are a U.S. citizen, you will need a valid passport to enter South Africa and return to the United States.

U.S. passport holders traveling to the Republic of South Africa for 90 days or less for tourism or business purposes do not need visas. Your passport must be valid six months beyond your intended stay and must contain at least two blank (unstamped) visa pages each time entry into the country is sought in addition to the endorsement/amendment pages at the back of the passport. Please be advised that if you do not comply with this regulation, you run the risk of being forced to return to your previous destination at your expense. Also be sure to allow yourself sufficient time to have your application processed if you are applying for a new passport or renewing an expired passport. Refer to the U.S. Department of State for further details.

There must be certified birth certificates for all children in a party who are under age 18. In addition, guests 18 years of age or younger may be required to show additional documentation when traveling with a single parent. If you are not a U. S. citizen, please check with the South African Embassy or Consulate for information on documentation requirements.

Passport/Visa Services

You can apply for a passport and/or visa through CIBT, Inc., a third party travel document company servicing the travel industry (not affiliated withthe Walt Disney Company). Learn more or call CIBT at (800) 406-1523. Be sure to mention Adventures by Disney, account #55134, for special pricing options.

PLEASE NOTE: ADDITIONAL CHARGES WILL APPLY FOR TELEPHONE CALLS made to access CIBT specialists.

What to Pack

Please limit your baggage to one piece of checked baggage per person plus one carry-on per person, due to internal flights within South Africa.

- 1 checked bag not to exceed 20kg/44lbs.
- 1 carry-on bag not to exceed 7kg/15lbs and not to exceed dimensions 22x14x9" (so that it can fit under the seat or in overhead compartment).
- 1 small item may also be carry-on, i.e. purse, coat, umbrella.

With frequent security changes, we recommend that you check with your air carrier as well as the Transportation Security Administration (TSA) for



current restrictions.

Comfortable shoes are needed as this adventure includes a considerable amount of walking. Most attire is casual, although one "smart casual" outfits recommended. Layered clothes are best, especially sweaters or jackets for cooler mornings and evenings.

Arrival/Departure Information

International Arrivals on Direct Flights into Cape Town

Upon arrival at Cape Town International Airport (CPT), follow airport signage to the passport control/immigration area. Once you've gone through passport control, follow additional airport signage directing you to baggage claim.

When you've secured your luggage, proceed to the Arrival Hall, where a representative holding an orange Adventures by Disney sign will greet you.

This representative is available to assist you with your luggage and will escort you to your prearranged ground transportation to your hotel.

International Arrivals into Johannesburg with a Connecting Flight to Cape Town

When boarding your first flight, it is important that your checked luggage is tagged through to Cape Town—not just to Johannesburg'this is to assure the luggage arrives at your ultimate destination in the event it's delayed or somehow routed separately) Even though Cape Town is the final destination and your luggage is tagged all the way through to Cape Town, you still will need to collect your luggage in Johannesburg to clear it through South African Customs control. Your international flight arrives in Johannesburg's Oliver R. Tambo International Airport (JNB). From your aircraft, proceed through passport control before collecting your luggage. Once cleared through Customs, you will turn your checked luggage back over to the luggage transfer desk. The personnel there will assure your luggage is then routed to your Cape Town flight. Once you arrive in Cape Town (CPT),

collect your luggage (which has already been cleared by Customs in Johannesburg) and proceed into the Arrival Hall where a representative holding an orange *Adventures by Disney* sign will greet you. Currency

The unit of monetary currency is the South African rand. ATM machines are available in most places to obtain cash in the local currency, and credit or debit cards are widely accepted. However, cash and travelers' checks are suggested to settle most accounts. From time to time you may have trouble paying with travelers' checks, but you will be able to exchange them at local banks or post offices. Your Adventure Guide can help you with any currency issues or language barriers.



Transportation

Adventures by Disney has arranged for all of your accommodation and transportation needs during your stay in South Africa as specified in your trip itinerary. If you choose to visit other parts of the country on your own, we highly advise you to hire a driver and car to escort you during your travels. Please ask your Adventure Guide for assistance regarding any transportation arrangements you may need.

Language

Besides English, South Africa has 10 other official languages: Afrikaans, Ndebele, Northern Sotho, Sotho, Swati, Tsonga, Tswana, Venda, Xhosa, and Zulu, with Afrikaans being the first or second language of the majority of South Africans. However, English is widely understood in urban areas and is the dominant language of the government and media.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I book my Adventures by Disney vacation?

To book your vacation, please call our Reservation Center at (800) 543-0865† and speak with aVacationista or contact your Travel Agent.

If you are outside the U.S., please call (866) 983-7872† and speak with a Vacationista or contact your Travel Agent.

Do I need vaccinations to travel to this country?

If you are coming from the U.S., you are advised to consult the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention regarding travel. Your doctor or health-care provider will determine what you will need, depending on factors such as your health and immunization history, areas of the country you will be visiting, and planned activities. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please check your local requirements for vaccinations for travel to South Africa.

What airport do I fly into and out of?

You will fly into Cape Town International Airport (CPT). International flights into Cape Town generally arrive midday if the flight is routed through a European gateway such as London or Frankfurt. Flights departing East Coast gateways such as Atlanta, Dulles or New York typically arrive in the evening hours in Cape Town. Some flights departing the USA may include a changeover in Johannesburg en route to Cape Town. Regardless of your flight's arrival time you will be met at the Cape Town airport and transferred to your hotel.

On the final day of the adventure, an early afternoon flight will bring you from Hoedspruit to O.R. Tambo International Airport (JNB) in Johannesburgfor your return flight home. To ensure a comfortable connection in Johannesburg, your evening flight should not be scheduled any time prior to 6:00 PM.


Are transfers included if I arrive or depart from different locations or at different times from the itinerary?

No. Transfers are only included from the specified arrival/departure airports and hotels. For South Africa, transfers are included from the Cape Town International Airport (CPT) to the Cape Town hotel on your arrival day. On your departure day, you will be flown to the O.R. Tambo International Airport (JNB) in Johannesburg with a mid-afternoon arrival time that comfortably allows connections to departing evening international flights.

Can I extend my vacation beyond the Adventures by Disney itinerary?

Yes, you may stay in South Africa before our itinerary begins. Pre-night stays in the Cape Town hotel are available at special rates if booked through Adventures by Disney Travel Services, Inc. in conjunction with a land package and cannot be combined with any other offer. Post-night stays are not available. Please contact a *Vacationista* at (800) 543-0865† for further information.

How will our group travel between destinations?



Travel from your hotels to sites in and near Cape Town and within the Garden Route region will be by motor coach. On Day 5, you will fly on a commercially scheduled flight from Cape Town to the Garden Route. On Day 7, you will fly on a commercially scheduled flight from the Garden Route to Hoedspruit via Johannesburg. On Day 10, you will fly on a commercially scheduled flight from Hoedspruit back to Johannesburg.

What is the climate like?

Since South Africa is situated in the southern hemisphere, its seasons are the reverse of those in North America, with midwinter in June and July and midsummer in December and January. In general, the country enjoys a sunny climate all year round. Cape Town and the southernmost part of the Western Cape have a mild, changeable winter—the time most rainfall occurs—and a warm to hot summer. The winters in the interior regions of the country, including the Kapama Game Reserve, are mostly dry, cool and often chilly at night. Early morning and evening game drives can be quite chilly and adequate warm clothing is required. Many guests find that a wool stretch cap, a scarf and gloves, combined with cool weather layers of clothes, are sufficient to remain comfortable. The game drive vehicles are equipped with wool blankets for covering legs and torsos. Summers are hot and experience more frequent rain.

How strenuous are the activities?

This is an active trip. However, all the activities are easy, and you can always choose to opt in or out as you wish. There are swimming pools at all 3 hotels; however, none are heated. There may be up to 2 hours of casual walking during a full day of activity in Cape Town and along the Garden Route. There is a short, easy bike ride in the Winelands area on Day 4. Game-viewing on Days 7-10 is enjoyed while riding in 4x4 vehicles. While nearly all of the trip's featured activities are gentle if enjoyed separately, the full range of activities requires a moderate amount of stamina in order to get the most of your vacation.

What ages are appropriate for this adventure?

We recommend that children be at least 8 years old at the time of travel on our South Africa trip. This is based on several factors including flight time and jet lag, time zone differences in the destination, duration of the vacation, extended hours of daily activity programming, number of internal transports between experiences, potential for extreme temperatures in the summer months, and the amount of physical activity involved. Last but not least, the game viewing at Kapama for the final 3 days of the trip involves close encounters with large wild animals such as lions, leopards, buffalo, hippos and rhinoceroses. A level of maturity is required to understand that sitting still and staying quiet is essential for fully enjoying this unique experience. Therefore, children should be a minimum of 6 years old for the game drives. What types of meals are served on this Adventures by Disney Trip?

Typically, breakfast is served each morning in buffet style and offers a variety of dishes. Dinners and lunches usually include fish, meat and pasta or

Can you accommodate special dietary needs?


