

Continue your thrilling snow experiences until it's time to travel back down the hill to Engelberg.



Visit a Cheese Factory in Engelberg

Head to a monastery for a tour of Switzerland's only show cheese factory. Watch cheese being made by hand and see how milk is transformed into the famous *Engelberger Klosterglocke*—a mild cheese pressed into the shape of a monastery bell. Discover other regional cheeses, milk products and souvenirs as well.

Private Farewell Dinner at the Old Swiss House in Lucerne

Be greeted on the deck of this landmark restaurant by 3 Swiss Alpen Horn Players playing traditional Swiss music—and then be served by wait staff wearing traditional Lucerne garb! The Old Swiss House has a half-timbered façade that dates back to 1859 and décor from the 17th century, stained-glass windows from the 16th century and original oil paintings by famous artists. Dine in a private area of this renowned restaurant that boasts a selection of gourmet menu items including the authentic Alpine specialty Wienerschnitzel. PREPARING FOR YOUR ADVENTURE

Required Travel Documentation

If you are a U.S. citizen, you will need a valid passport to enter Italy and Switzerland and return to the United States. Your passport must be valid six months beyond your intended stay and have 1-2 blank pages remaining. Allow yourself sufficient time to have your application processed if you are applying for a new passport or renewing an expired passport. Refer to the U.S. Department of State for further details.

In addition, Guests 17 years of age or younger may be required to show additional documentation when traveling with a single parent.

If you are not a U.S. citizen, please check with the Italian Embassy and the Swiss Embassy for information on documentation requirements.

Passport/Visa Services

You can apply for a passport and/or visa through CIBT, Inc., a third party travel document company servicing the travel industry (not affiliated withthe Walt Disney Company). Learn more or call CIBT at (800) 406-1523. Be sure to mention Adventures by Disney, account #55134, for special pricing options.

EN ROUTE

Arrival/Departure Information

After arriving at Milan Malpensa Airport (MXP) prior to 2:30 PM, you may pass through Immigration and Passport Control. This is dependent on your departure city and where your flight connections were. Follow airport signage to Baggage Claim. Retrieve your luggage and exit the Baggage Claim area by passing through Customs and then into the main terminal. As soon as you arrive in the Arrivals Hall of the terminal, look for a representative holding an orange *Adventures by Disney* sign. This representative is available to assist you with your luggage and will escort you to your prearranged ground transportation to your hotel. At the end of the adventure, you will fly out of Zurich Airport (ZRH) for your return flight home. Your flight is expected to depart no earlier than 10:00 AM.

DURING YOUR ADVENTURE

Currency

The unit of currency in Italy is the Euro (EUR), and the Swiss Franc (CHF) is used in Switzerland. U.S. dollars are not accepted at hotels, shops or restaurants, but ATM machines are available in most places. Most hotels and restaurants accept major credit cards or debit cards. Your Adventure Guide can help you with any local currency issues that may arise.

Gratuities

Adventure Guide Gratuities

Gratuities for your Adventure Guides are not included. Based on the quality of service you have received, we suggest the following gratuityguidelines.

Please note that this is for each member of your traveling party, per Adventure Guide, per day.

Per Adult/Child/Per Adventure Guide/Per Day—\$8 - \$11 USD

Example:

- For an 8-day adventure, the Adventure Guide gratuity per Guest, per Adventure Guide: \$64 \$88 USD.
- A family of 4 for an 8-day adventure: \$256 \$352 USD per Adventure Guide.



For two guides, this is a total of \$512 - \$704 USD.

The Adventure Guides gratuity can be paid in U.S dollars, local currency, travelers' checks or PayPal. Please check with your Adventure Guide if they accept PayPal.

All Other Gratuities

Gratuities have been taken care of on your behalf for all services included in the itinerary. There is no need for you to worry about tipping the bellmen, housekeepers, waiters, drivers and local experts.

Transportation

While we take care of transportation to all itinerary destinations, here are some helpful transportation tips for time on your own.

ITALY

Accommodations have been arranged so that anything you may need while in Stresa is situated within walking distance via pedestrian streets, some of which are cobblestone. If additional transportation needs arise, your Adventure Guide can provide assistance.

SWITZERLAND

When traveling in Switzerland, it's best to avoid Swiss roads and opt for the wonderfully punctual and ultra-efficient rail system. You can buy ticketsat any of the numerous kiosks, most of which accept cash or credit and give information in many different languages. Helpful ticket sales people will give you a copy of your itinerary, which includes information like transfer stations, time of transfer and which car to enter. To get to more remote places not on the rail-line, take a "postbus," which is integrated into the rail system.

Language

While the primary language of Italy is Italian and the primary language of central Switzerland is German, most people from both countries speak some English. Your Adventure Guide can help you with any language barriers.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How do I book my Adventures by Disney vacation?

To book your vacation, please call our Reservation Center at (800) 543-0865† and speak with a Vacationista or contact your Travel Agent.

If you are outside the U.S., please call (866) 983-7872† and speak with a Vacationista or contact your travel agent.

Do I need vaccinations to travel to this country?

If you are a U.S. citizen, you do not need vaccinations to travel to Italy or Switzerland. If you are not a U.S. citizen, please check your local requirements on vaccinations for travel to Italy and Switzerland.

What airport do I fly into and out of?

ARRIVAL: You will fly into Malpensa Airport (MXP) in Milan on your arrival day. Your flight should arrive prior to 2:30 PM

DEPARTURE: At the end of the adventure, you will fly out of Zurich Airport (ZRH) for your return flight home. You can depart any time after 10:00 AM.

Are transfers included if I arrive or depart from different locations or at different times from the itinerary?

No. Transfers are only included from the specified arrival/departure airports and hotels. For the Italy & Switzerland trip, transfers are included from Malpensa International Airport (MXP) in Milan to the Regina Palace Hotel on your arrival day. On your departure day, transfers are included from Hotel Luzern Schweizerhof or Hotel Continental Park Luzern to the Zurich Airport (ZRH).

Can I extend my vacation beyond the Adventures by Disney itinerary?

Yes, you may stay in Italy before or Switzerland after our itinerary. Extended stays are available at special rates if booked through Adventures by Disney Travel Services, Inc. in conjunction with a land package and cannot be combined with any other offer. Please contact aVacationista at (800) 543-0865† for further information.

How will our group travel between destinations?

Your group will travel by motor coach between destinations in Italy and Switzerland. In Switzerland you will travel by train to the town of Zermatt, where no cars are allowed.

How strenuous are the activities?

While in Switzerland, the altitude ranges from 5,276 feet (1,608 meters) above sea level to just over 10,000 feet (3,048 meters) above sea level.



Most of the trip occurs at 5,000 feet. However, the altitude rises as high as 7,500 feet for a short coach ride on the Simplon Pass.

The trip includes a canopy zip lining experience (size restrictions apply) and a gentle bike ride on a paved path. While nearly all of the trip's featured activities are gentle if enjoyed separately, the full range of activities requires a moderate amount of stamina in order to get the most out of your vacation.

What ages are appropriate for this adventure?

While we welcome children ages 4 and up on our Italy & Switzerland trip, we recommend that children be at least 6 years old at the time of travel. This is based on several factors, such as flight time and jet lag, time zone differences in the destination, duration of the vacation, extended hours of daily activity programming, number of internal transports between experiences, potential for extreme temperatures in the summer months, and amount of physical activity (e.g., walking, biking, and zip lining). Because each child is different, call a*Vacationista* at (800) 543-0865† to discuss whether this is the right trip for your kids.

What types of meals are served on this Adventures by Disney Trip?

Typically, breakfast is served each morning in buffet style and offers a variety of dishes. Dinners and lunches usually include fish, meat, and pasta or rice entrées; vegetables and salad; and desserts and fruit. Some included meals on this trip are served buffet style while others offer a limited-choice menu. Given the nature of group travel, we regret that *a la carte* menu choices may not always be available. Children-friendly choices are available at all meals. Menu items are subject to change due to the availability and seasonality of foods. 
